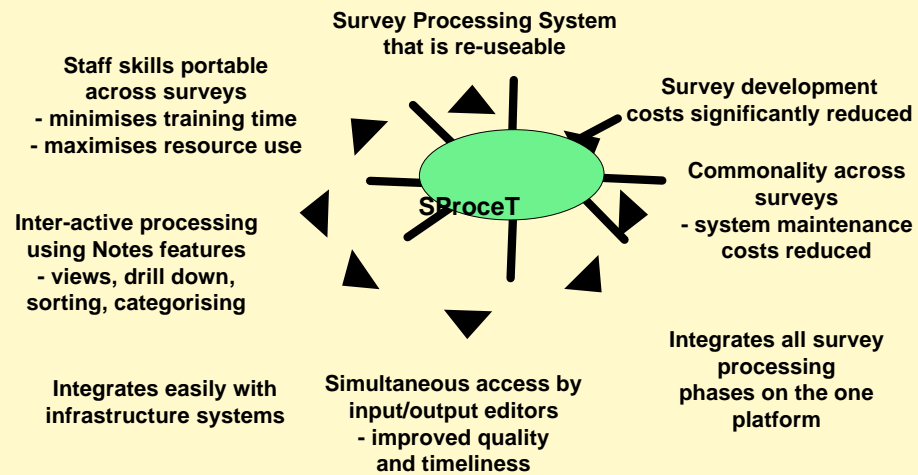

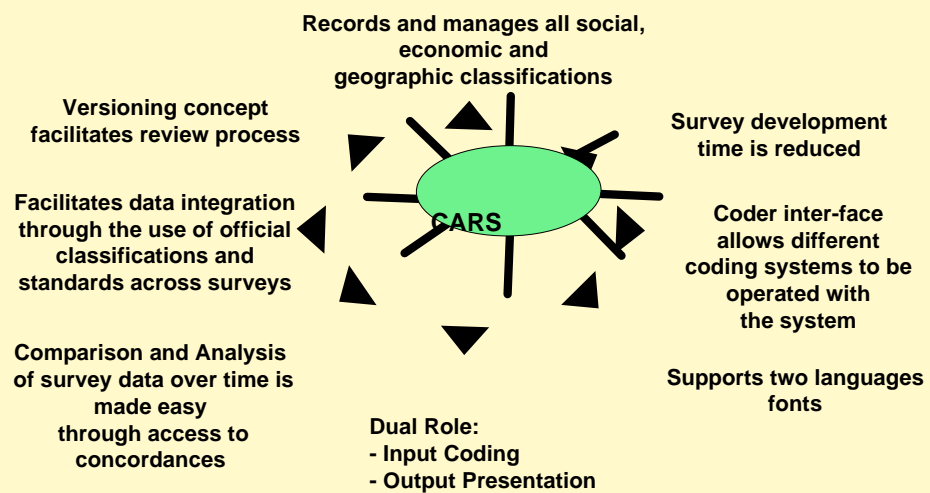

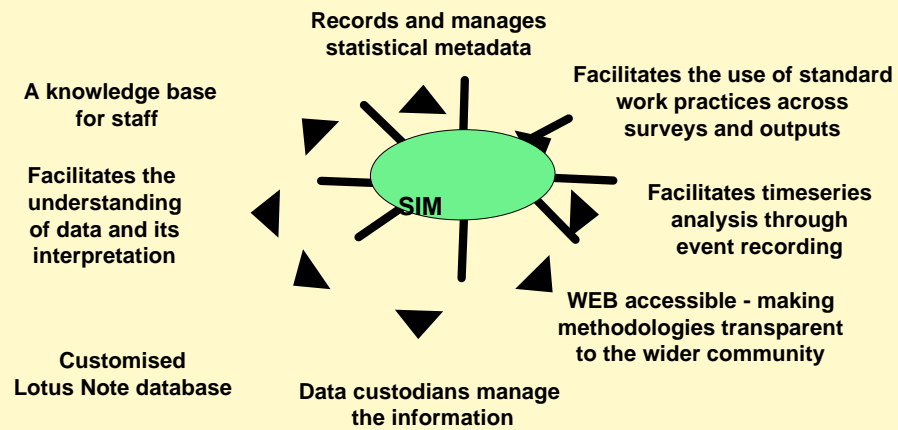
## Survey Processing Template

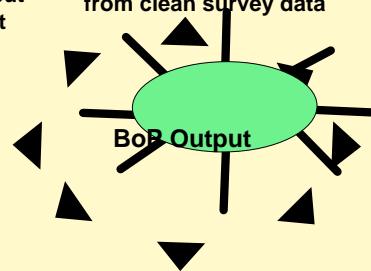
## Balance of Payments Output System

Uses formulae (user definable) to automatically derive additional input/output from existing input/output

Compiles Balance of Payments, foreign debt and international investment position statistics from clean survey data

Comprehensive link from output to unit records on the same platform

Has user driven tools to define and add new input and output variables



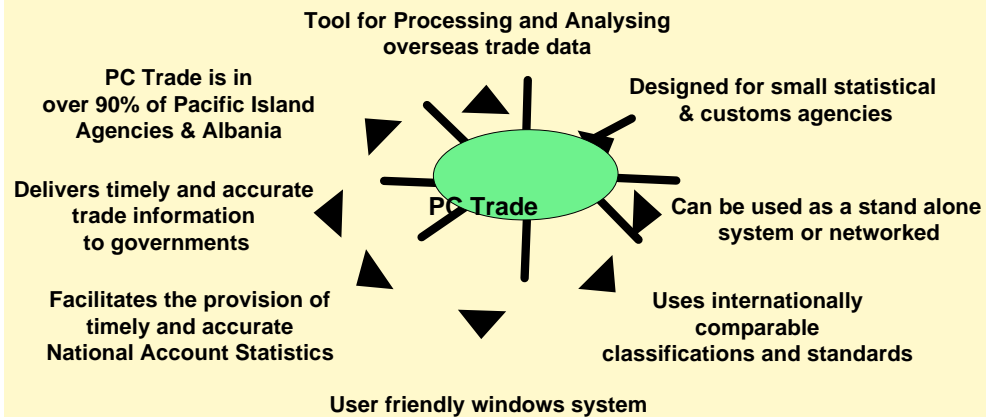
Can view time series by each survey respondent
