Industry Definitions

- Prepackaged Software
 - Software Publishing
- Data Processing Services
 - Data Processing, Hosting, and Related Services
- On-line Information Services
 - Internet Service Providers and Web Search Portals

Prepackaged Software has been reclassified as software publishing because the activity -- creation of a copyrighted product and bringing it to market -- is equivalent to the creation process for other types of intellectual products. Reproduction of pre-packaged software is treated as a manufacturing activity and custom design of software to client specifications remains in Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services. These distinctions arise because of the different ways that software is created, reproduced, and distributed.

 - Maintenance, documentation, training, and other software services

- Product substitution during monthly data review
 - Timing of substitution
 - Version changes or updates are directly compared when there are no new capabilities
 - Price differences linked out when sub is new generation product (not comparable)



- Item Augmentation
 - Current reporters only
 - New items only
 - Retail sales of software used to sample
 - Reallocation of current reporters item weights when necessary



- Directed substitution
 - Annual update of products from current reporters
 - Resampling of products (disaggregation)

- Sample Augmentation
 - Frame source for new entries into the industry
 - Identifying companies producing revolutionary new products
 - Weighting new companies
 - Revising publication structure

- Hedonic model
 - Variety of products
 - Limited uses for model



- Producer cost quality adjustment
 - Research and development costs
 - Projected number of licenses
 - Secondary sources used if reporter cannot provide the data
