- Continuing increase in importance of service activities
- Long OECD interest in how countries measure and deflate services output

OECD

- Support Voorburg Group PPI work
- Inform work of OECD-Eurostat Task Force
- An information exchange resource for countries
- Annual survey began in 1997

The 2002 Inquiry

Consultation with Eurostat on questions
Questionnaire sent on 12 July to 46 countries
Asking whether service PPIs compiled
Information requested:

new price surveys since July 2001

- future plans
- discontinued surveys
- details of service PPI publication
- methodological documentation
- use as deflators in national accounts
- contact name
- comments on 2001 report



2002 Results

Eurostat participation increased level of interest especially in Europe Information received from 26 countries in 2002 – 24 directly

- 2 more which sent regular data to OECD
- Cumulative total of 34 countries have replied in 6 years
- 20 countries collect some services PPIs or 'corporate prices'(One new one CH)
- 3 new respondents this year Bulgaria, Estonia, Lithuania do not collect
 - But wish to be kept informed



2002 results II

Most popular services for PPI compilation Telecoms (ISIC 642) 16 countries Hotels (551) 15 Sea and air transport (611&621) 12 Road Freight (6023) 11 Railways (601) 11 Accounting (7412) 11 Architecture and Engineering services (7421) 11

• Data collection evenly split between M and Q (Very few A or 6M)



2002 results: New surveys

New surveys since July 2001 or planned to start in 2002

- 34 new surveys by 8 countries
- Slightly up on 2001
 - Motor trades & retail 3
 - Hotels 3
 - Road freight 1
 - Telecoms 4
 - Rental of machinery 2
 - Computer services 11
 - Legal services 2
 - Market research 1
 - Engineering serv 3
 - Advertising 1
 - Labour provision 1
 - TV broadcasting 1

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Other results

Products: 16 countries have provided information on products priced

- CPC framework in table 3
- But few countries use CPC directly so many non-CPC descriptions are provided
- Useful in summarising what is being priced
- 11 responded to question on deflators (see table 6)
- Well-established series are nearly always used as deflators of output
- Expansion of data publication details in report
- OECD has received a range of national methodological reports which are mentioned in the report and can be shared on request



Some conclusions and questions

- Service PPI rate of progress increased slightly since July 2001
- Some more countries thinking about starting this work
- Nonetheless progress is slow
 - Conceptual basis problems
 - High level of development work needed
 - Need to pass quality tests
- Telecoms, software, hotels, transport and business services seem to enjoy some priority
- Financial services are difficult
- Does the Group wish this survey to continue?
- What other information is needed?
