- Content Development Framework, Attachment A, Lists 150 service industries (as defined by ISIC Rev. 4)
- Scope has provisionally increased to include Retail and Wholesale Trade (41 industries) and Repair of Goods and Installation of Machinery (8 industries) = 49 additional industries
- Priorities were assigned to the top 17 industry/industry groups at the 2007 VG Meeting
- We are still on track to complete the initial sweep of industry/industry group priorities (established in 2007) by 2011
