FRIBS – project

(Framework regulation for integrating business statistics) General objectives

- reduction of burden on respondents
- improvement of the general quality of business statistics
- improvement of the relevance of business statistics

Architecture

- infrastructural component
- manual as a component providing the methodological framework
- data structure as the component defining data requirements



STS - package

main proposals for services and trade in the first draft

- introduction of a monthly index of services production
- transition from a quarterly calculation of an index of turnover to a monthly calculation
- <u>extension of the coverage</u> of the service sector by inclusion of additional service industries
- inclusion of <u>additional SPPIs</u> if required for the calculation of ISPs
- inclusion of a comprehensive trade volume indicator

Issues of the ISP Task Force

Industry specific issues

- Possibility to combine SPPIs with consumer prices
- Effects of differences in the updates of weights
- match turnover data with price indices for deflation in areas with a large share of secondary activities
- allocation of general turnover between business and private consumption

Benefits of monthly service turnover data

- Seasonality or result of special budgetary and payment arrangements?

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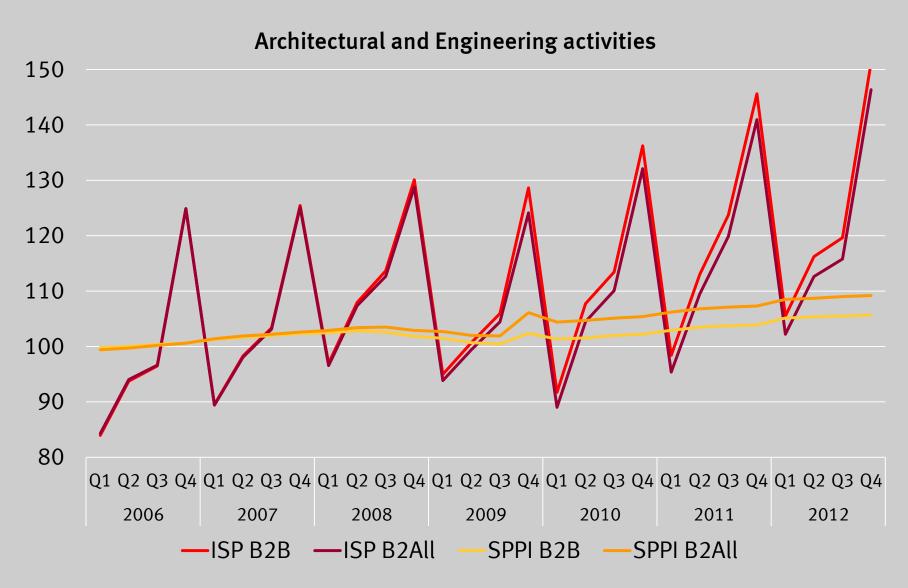




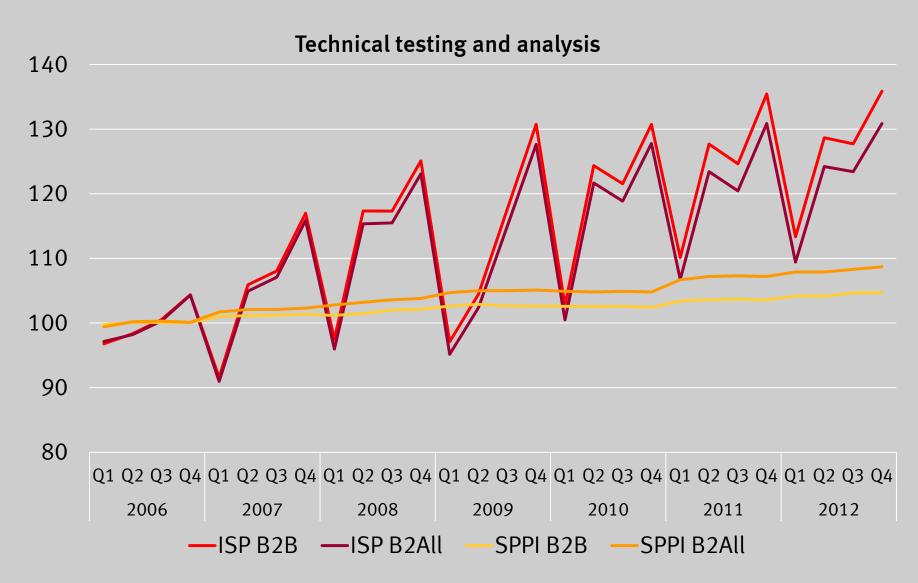




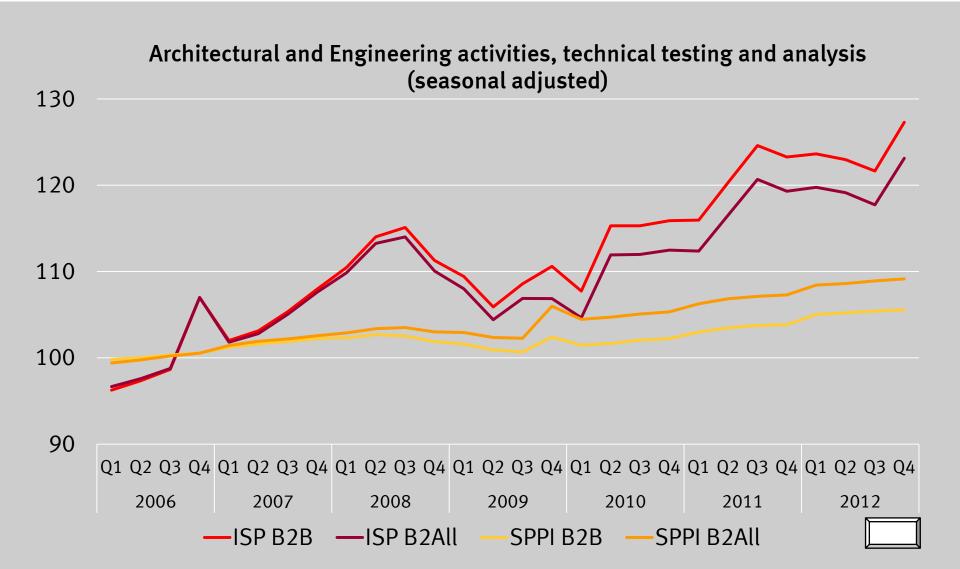
