Quality adjustment for a Fixed Input-Output Price Index

Following the positive interest of some members of Ottawa Group, Voorburg Group will consult with price experts to clarify the topic with examples of the impact of using different concepts for quality adjustment

- Clarify what is meant by a Fixed-Input Output Price Index
- Demonstrate this framework on output SPPIs for service industries
- Provide examples of the data resulting from the same change in services calculated through a resource cost approach and through a consumer utility approach
- Provide recommendations on how National Statistics Offices should apply quality adjustments to changing services
