First attempt in France

Patrice ROUSSEL INSEE 1998 was the first year France experimented a deregulation in telecommunication market.

In 1999 the Telecom Regulation Authority launched a first administrative data collection from the telecommunication carriers (approximatively 70) and committed INSEE in a project of Telecom inquiry to be done annually from 2000, on Telecom carriers and services providers.

The following charts give the overall structure of the two data collection.

Being a first attempt, at the very starting point of the expansion of the telecommunication new market in France (as in other countries), those drafts must be taken as provisionnal, but they show already clearly that from a CPC point of view, a mix of the following items of the product classification :
