♦ Weight Revision

Currently, we are revising all the industry based index weights and commodity index weight to 1997 Economic Census data. The indices will be published in January 2002 based on the revised weight data.

Quality Improvement Initiative

In order to address new item bias, a new directed substitution procedure was introduced. Approximately two years prior to the introduction of a new sample into the index all current reporters are contacted to determine if the items they are reporting are still representative. A probability sampling technique is used to determine if a substitution is required. Quality adjustment is attempted on any substitutions.

Specific industry specific quality improvements are being employed. These include use of hedonic models for quality adjustment, alternative quality adjustment techniques, and sample augmentation.
