# ISIC REVISION 3 AND SERVICE INDUSTRIES' CLASSIFICATION IN OECD COUNTRIES: A TENTATIVE COMPARISON

- 1. The attached table "ISIC Revision 3 and National Classifications of Service Industries in 15 OECD Countries" aims at showing the extent to which ISIC Revision 3 (hereafter referred to as ISIC), may be implemented using services data presently provided in OECD Countries' National Accounts publications. National classifications referred to are those used to break down Gross Domestic Product by kind of service activity. At a later stage, the document will the extended to all OECD Countries.
- 2. The table been set up along the following lines:
  - -- The first column to the left lists ISIC service activities and their corresponding codes. All items at the two-digit "Division" level and most items at the three-digit "Group" level are shown. At this level, the non reported items relate to the breakdown of some business services and of Education. Only a few items at the four-digit "Class" level are given. The principle underlying the selection of headings consisted in listing all sub-groups of a category, at a given level of the classification, if at least one sub-group of the category was reported separately by one of the 15 countries. Conversely, groups or classes for which no estimate was published by any of the countries have not been listed.
  - -- Education and Health have been subdivided into market and non market services, although ISIC does not make this distinction. Other non market services estimated separately from their market counterparts are mentioned in the footnotes.
  - -- Crosses in the Country columns indicate which ISIC items are given in national sources or can be derived from them by grouping several separate headings. Brackets group ISIC items published under a single heading in Country data, and figures in parentheses refer to footnotes which indicate differences between ISIC and national classifications.
  - -- Private non profit institutions published separately in country data have been classified to ISIC items "Activities of membership organisation n.e.c." or "Activities of other membership organisations" according to their coverage.
- 3. At this preliminary stage, it appears from the table that major ISIC categories "Hotels and restaurants". "Transport, storage and communication", "Financial intermediation", "Public administration and defence; compulsory social security" and "Private households with employed staff" are more frequently comparable to definitions in national classifications than the other categories of service activities. At least 10 countries appear consistent with ISIC on the coverage of these items. "Hotels and restaurants" is reported by 10 out of the 15 countries reviewed, "Transport, storage and communication" is

reported by all 15 countries and the only inconsistency noted with ISIC relates to rental and leasing of motor vehicles which are included in this item in the Austrian classification. "Financial intermediation" is reported by countries, on the assumption that Japan, Canada, Denmark, Finland, the Netherlands, and Norway include activities auxiliary to banking and to insurance with financial institutions and insurance. "Public administration and defence; compulsory social security" is provided by 10 countries. The others include under the matching heading in their classifications non market educational, health, recreational and cultural services produced by government. "Private households with employed persons" is provided by 10 countries.

- Data consistent with the other ISIC service categories are more scarce. "Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and personal and household services" appear to be available for 5 countries Inconsistencies are mainly due to a different classification of repair and rental services which are seldom published separately in National Accounts For a small number of countries, the lack of comparability is due to the classification of hotels and restaurants. These inconsistencies also reflect on comparability of categories "Real estate, renting and business services" and on "Other community, social and personal services". The former appears available for seven countries and the latter for only one. "Education" and "Health and social work" is published separately in five countries; inconsistencies with ISIC on these items stem mainly from the treatment of non market services in national nomenclatures and also from the classification of veterinary services and social work.
- At the two-digit level of ISIC data is available for divisions of "Transport, storage and communication", "Financial intermediation", "Real estate, renting and business services" : five countries give "Land transport; transport via pipelines", eight countries give water transport, six give air transport and "Supporting and auxiliary transport activities; activities of travel agencies". "Post and telecommunication" is available for 12 countries. "Financial intermediation except insurance and pension funding" and "Insurance and pension funding except compulsory social security" are provided separately for 10 countries. "Real estate activities" are given by 11 countries, though, for three of them, the item only covers dwellings. "Recreational, cultural and sporting activities" are reported separately for eight countries, though in one case the item only includes non market services. Other items at the two-digit level are only given for one or two countries or are not available at all.
- A minority of the countries reviewed report items at the three-or four-digit level. "Maintenance and repair of motor vehicles" and "Repair of personal and household goods" are given by three countries, "Hotels: camping sites and other provision of short-term accommodation" by two, "Restaurants, bars and canteens" by one. "Transport via railways" is provided by seven countries, and the breakdown of water transport between "Sea and coastal transport" and "Inland water transport" by three. "Storage and warehousing" is found once, so is the breakdown of "Post and telecommunications" between "Post courier activities" and "Telecommunications" and of "Financial intermediation". "Legal activities", "Advertising", "Photographic activities" are also reported by one country only. "Defence activities", "Compulsory social security activities" and "Social work activities" are given by three countries. "Motion picture projection" is given twice and "Washing and (dry-) cleaning of textile and fur products" once.

7. As already mentioned, this is a tentative comparison and it would be very helpful if national experts would check comments relating to their country. Annex 1 gives the sources used to set up the Table and annex 2 list a few specific questions addressed to countries.

- (1) Item Retail trade includes sales of motor vehicles and gasoline service station in US SIC. It also includes eating and drinking places.
- (2) Repair of motor vehicles includes car rentals in US SIC.
- (3) Item Wholesale trade in US NIPA includes sales of motor vehicles and motor vehicle parts and supplies.
- (4) Repair of personal and household goods is not included in Retail trade in US SIC but is published as a separate item in NIPA under heading "Miscellaneous repair services".
- (5) Item "Other land transport" derived by adding published NIPA items "Trucking and warehousing" and "Local and interurban passenger transit" would then include Storage.
- (6) Supporting and auxiliary transport activities exclude Storage in US National Accounts.
- (7) Private courrier services are classified under Transport in US NIPA, and the US postal service under Federal government enterprises.
- [8] Telecommunications include radio and television broadcasting in US NIPA.
- [9] ISIC item "Monetary intermediation" is matched with NIPA item "Banking".
- (10) ISIC item "Other financial intermediation" is matched with NIPA items "Credit agencies other than banks" and "Holding and other investment companies".
- (11) This item is derived by summing NIPA items "Real estate", "Business services", "Legal activities" and "Miscellaneous professional activities". It excludes rentals of recreation and cultural goods and of automobiles and trucks.
- (12) Real estate excludes farm housing in NIPA.
- (13) Social work activities are published together with Membership organisations in NIPA

- (16) Item "Wholesale and retail trade" excludes Repair services in the German classification.
- (17) Sales of motor vehicles are not given separately in German National Accounts.
- (18) Item "Water transport" includes Ports and Supporting services to water transport in German National Accounts.
- (19) Item "Post and telecommunications" covers the Deutsche Bundespost in the German classification.

- (20) Item "Wholesale and retail trade; repairs of motor vehicles, motorcycles and personal and household goods" excludes Repair of personal and hausehold goods in French National Accounts. At level 40 of the NAP they are included in item "Market services rendered to households" but are available separately at level 90 of the NAP. Recovery of waste and scrap materials is excluded from Wholesale and retail trade and classified with "Market services rendered to enterprises" at level 40 of the NAP and is given separately at level 90 of the NAP.
- (21) Items "Financial services" and "Insurance services" exclude activities auxiliary to Financial intermediation in French National Accounts.
- (22) Item "Renting of machinery and equipment without operator and of personal and household goods" is available at level 90 of the French NAP. At level 40 it is included in "Market services rendered to enterprises".
- (23) Item "Business services" (Market services rendered to enterprises) includes "Recovery of waste and scrap materials" in French National Accounts.
- (24) Non market social work activities are given separately at level 90 of the NAP in French National Accounts.
- (25) Non market recreational, cultural and sport services are provided separately at level 90 of the French NAP. Corresponding market services are included in "Market services rendered to households".

(26) Cross corresponds to item "Other market services" available at level 90 of the NAP, included in "Market services rendered to households" published at level 40 of the NAP in French National Accounts.

# United Kingdom

- (27) "Wholesale and retail trade, repairs, hotels and restaurants" are published as a single item in UK National Accounts. Repairs exclude dothing repairs.
- [28] Financial intermediation, real estate, renting and business services are published under a single heading in UK. National Accounts. Activities auxiliary to Banking, finance and insurance are included in Business services. Research and development are excluded.
- (29) Education and Health services are grouped under a single heading. They include market and non market services in UK National Accounts. Social work is excluded,
- (30) ISIC item "Other community, social and personal services activities" is matched with item Other services in UK National Accounts and comprises Sanitary services, Research and development, social welfare and community services, Membership organisations, Tourist offices, Recreational and other cultural services, personal services and domestic services.

# Haly

- (31) Real estate activities cover owner and tenant occupied dwellings and rentals of non residential buildings
- (32) Business services, Market educational, health, recreational, cultural and sporting activities and Personal and household services are grouped under one heading.
- (33) Non market educational, health, cultural services produced by government are included in item "Public administration" in Italian National Accounts.
- (34) Private households with employed persons are grouped with Nan profit institutions serving households and Religious organisations in Italian National Accounts.

# Canada

- (35) Item "Wholesale and retail trade" excludes Repair services to personal goods, to electric motors and welding.
- (36) Supporting services to transport, except Storage and warehousing are not given as a separate item but grouped with the relevant transport service in the Canadian classification. Travel agencies are classified under Other service industries.
- (37) Post and telecommunications includes Radio and television broadcasting in Canadian National Accounts.

P. 07

- (38) Item "Real estate, renting and business services" excludes Rentals of machinery and equipment, vehicles, and personal and household goods in Canadian National Accounts.
- (39) Other health activities include Social work activities in Canadian National Accounts.

#### **Austria**

- (40) Wholesale and retail trade include Machinery and equipment rental and leasing except rental and leasing of motor vehicles in Austrian National Accounts and exclude Repair services.
- (41) Item "Transport, storage and communications" includes rental and leasing of motor vehicles.
- (42) Activities auxiliary to Finance and insurance are not given as a separate item in Austrian National Accounts.
- [43] Rentals are included in "Wholesale and retail trade" or in "Transport" in Austrian National Accounts (see notes 40 and 41).
- (44) ISIC item "Public administration and defence; compulsory social security" is matched with "Öffentliche Dienste" which includes Non market educational, health, recreational and cultural services produced by government in Austrian National Accounts.
- (45) ISIC categories M, N, O except Activities of membership arganisations are matched with item Other market services given in Austrian National Accounts. It includes health, educational, recreational and cultural services produced by Non profit institutions serving households.
- (46) ISIC item "Activities of membership organisations n.e.c." is matched with Austrian heading Non profit institutions serving households which includes Religious organisations, political parties, trade unions.

# Denmark

- (47) Repair of mater vehicles is published as a separate item in Danish National Accounts. Repair of personal and household goods are dassified under "Household services".
- (48) Sales of motor vehicles are not published separately.
- (49) Item "Rail transport" includes Bus transport in the Danish classification.
- (50) ISIC item "Real estate activities" is matched with Danish National Accounts item "Dwellings".

- (51) ISIC item "Public administration and defence; compulsory social security" is matched with Danish item "Producers of government services" which includes Non market educational, health, recreational and cultural services produced by government.
- (52) ISIC item "Other service activities" is matched with Danish item "Hausehold services".

### Finland

- (53) Sales of motor vehicles are not given separately in Finnish National Accounts.
- (54) Item Education includes Research and scientific institutions in the Finnish dassification.
- (55) ISIC item "Activities of other membership organisations" is matched with Finnish item "Other social and related community services" produced by non profit organisations.
- (56) Finnish National Accounts provide separate estimates for market and non market recreational and cultural services produced by government and by non profit organisations.
- (57) ISIC item "Other service activities" is matched with Finnish item "Personal and household services".

# **Netherlands**

- (58) ISIC item "Land transport, transport via pipelines" is matched with item "Other transport and storage" given in Dutch National Accounts.
- (59) Real estate covers tenant and owner occupied housing in Dutch National Accounts.
- (60) ISIC item "Social work activities" is matched with Dutch item "Social services" which includes non subsidized education.
- (61) ISIC item "Other service activities" is matched with Dutch item "Enterprises producing services n.e.c.".

# Norway

- (62) Repair of motor vehicles and consumer goods are published under a single heading in Norwegian National Accounts.
- (63) ISIC item "Real estate activities" is matched with Norwegian items "Real estate except dwellings" and "Dwellings".

- (64) In Norwegian National Accounts administration and regulation of health, educational, recreational and cultural services are not separated from actual provision of the services.
- (65) Market human health and Veterinary services are published under a single heading in Norwegian National Accounts.
- (66) ISIC item "Social work activities" are matched with item "Welfare services" of the Norwegian classification. Market services and non market services produced by government are given separately.
- (67) ISIC item "Activities of membership organisations n.e.c." is matched with item "Professional and labour associations".
- (68) ISIC item "Other service activities" is matched with Norwegian item "Miscellaneous personal services".

#### Sweden

- (69) Repairs to motor vehicles and cycles and to consumer goods are classified with Personal and household services but are published as a separate item in Swedish National Accounts.
- [70] Swedish frem "Producers of central and local government services" includes non-market educational, health, recreational and cultural services produced by government.
- [71] Market education and health services are published under a single heading in Swedish National Accounts
- [72] ISIC item "Other service activities" is matched with Swedish item "Other personal services".
- (73) Private households with employed persons are published together with Non profit institutions serving households in Swedish National Accounts.

# Australia

- (74) ISIC items "Financial intermediation" and "Real estate, renting and business services" are matched with Australian items "Finance, property and business services" and "Ownership of dwellings". Business services include car rentals in the Australian classification.
- (75) ISIC items "Education" and "Health and social work" are matched with Australian item "Community services".

# **New Zealand**

(76) Wholesale and retail trade is grouped with Restaurants and hotels under one heading.

- (77) ISIC items "Financial intermediation" and "Real estate, renting and business services" are matched with New Zealand items "Financing, insurance, real estate and business services" and "Owner occupied dwellings".
- (78) ISIC item "Public administration and defence; compulsory social security" is matched with New Zealand items "Central government services" and "Local government services" which include non market health, education, research, recreational, cultural and welfare services in New Zealand National Accounts.
- (79) Cross corresponds to New Zealand items "Community and personal services" and "Private non profit services".
