#### 1 Introduction

In Japan, statistical system of the national government is decentralized system, in which ministries and agencies execute statistical surveys concerning the matters under their jurisdiction. Under this system, problems may arise on the integration of statistical systems and the reporting burden of the general public. Therefore, Statistical Standards Department. Statistics Bureau, Management and Coordination Agency takes charge of overall coordination of governmental statistical activities based on the Statistics Law(1947), the Statistical Reports Coordination Law(1952) and so on.

# 2 Outline of Standard Industrial Classification for Japan

#### 2.1 Position of JSIC in Japan

The purpose of the Statistics Law promulgated 1947 after the World War II is to secure the truthfulness of statistics, to eliminate the duplication of statistical surveys, to consolidate the statistical system, and to improve the frameworks of statistics.

In order to complete the purpose, the law prescribes the designation system of important statistics such as population census, obligation to answer questionaires of designated statistics, protection of secret collected by statistical surveys, and so on.

Concerning the statistical standards, a Cabinet Order based on the law prescribes that, when executor of statistical survey indicates its result by industry, Standard Industrial Classification for Japan (JSIC) notified publicly by Minister of the Management and Coordination Agency (MCA) should be used. And this rule is applied to executors of statistical surveys for designated statistics, national government, Bank of Japan and Japan Chamber of Commerce.

#### 2.2 History of JSIC

JSIC was established in 1949 by the Statistics Committee (former organization of Statistical Standards Department and Statistics Council), and was made a statistical standard based on a Cabinet Order in 1950.

JSIC has been revised nine times until 1984.

### 2.3 Use of JSIC in Japan

JSIC is not only used as a statistical standard of many important statistics as explained in para. 2.1, but also used for deciding applied types of industries or businesses in administration for tax, subsidy, financing and in private sector for financing, deta information business and so on, because JSIC is an only classification of whole industrial activities

in our country.

# - 2.4 Relationship between Standard Classifications for Japan and International Standard Classifications

Outline of relationship is shown in Annex 1.

Basic attitude of Statistical Standards Department to the relationship between standard classifications for Japan and international standard classifications is to keep unification of both classifications as possible as we can, and make ours more similar ones to international standard classifications.

But nowadays, as we can not adopt international standard classifications without amendment instead of our-classifications, we are making efforts to develop conversion tables in order to progress exchange and international comparison of statistical data.

#### 3 General System of JSIC Revision

#### 3.1 Outline of JSIC Revision Procedures

As revision of JSIC needs professional and technical studies from various viewpoints, after the study of Statistical Standards Department whether revision is necessary or not, Minister of MCA usually requests its advisory council for etatistical administration, "Statistics Council", to make examination for revision and make recommendations.

After getting recommendations of JSIC revision by the Council, Minister of MCA notifies its revision publicly based on the Cabinet Order on "Standard Industrial Classification for Statistical Surveys and Classification of Diseases, Injuries, and Causes of Death".

#### 3.2 Organization of Statistics Council for the examination of JSIC Revision

Statistics Council is established as a permanent advisory council on government statistical administration based on the Establishment Law of MCA. The Council consists of 7 leading experts in statistics. 6 representatives of ministries having statistics bureau or department (MCA, Ministry of Health and Welfare, Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, Ministry of International Trade and Industry, Ministry of Transport, Ministry of Labour), one representative of prefectures conducting most of statistical surveys (Tokyo Metropolis Statistics Department), and 4 representatives of main statistics users (Economic Planning Agency, Bank of Japan, Federation of Economic Organization and so on ).

Under the Council there are thirteen Subcouncils. One of them is the Expert Subcouncil for Statistical Classifications consisted by a few leading

expert members, some sub-expert members and directors in charge of statistics of ministries and agencies in concern.

Under the Expert Subcouncil for Statistical Classifications, Study Group for Statistical Industrial Classification, which is composed of some expert in industrial classification and staffs of ministries and agencies in concern, is organized for technical and professional examination.

# 3.3 Proposals for Revision, their Examination and Recommendation of the Council

Proposals, opinions and requests of ministries, agencies and other private sector's organizations are collected through divisions in charge of statistics in ministries and agencies in concern by Statistical Standards Department. And these are examined respectively from various viewpoints by the study group and Subcouncil. After these examination, proposal for revision of JSIC is considered as a whole by the Statistics Council and the Council presents its recommendation to the Minister of MCA.

# U Outline of Tenth Revision of JSIC

## 4.1 Background

Background of tenth revision of JSIC is to adjust JSIC rev.9 notified in 1984 to social and economic changes in our society caused by technological innovation, business diversification, and growth of service.

And also it is one of main reasons to secure comparability with International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC rev.3) revised in February 1991 by UNSO.

## 4.2 Revision Schedule

In June 1990, studies for tenth revision by Statistical Standards Department was started with some experts and staffs of ministries and agencies in concern of the Subcouncil before MCA Minister's formal request.

MCA Minister's formal request to the Statistics Council was made in June 1991. And the Council's recommendation was submitted to the Minister on 9th July, 1993.

In these three years, the Statistics Council was hold twice, the Expert Subcouncil for Statistical Classifications was hold 22 times, the Study Group for Statistical Industrial Classification was hold 30 times, and also staff meeting for consultation and coordination of works and contents among Statistical Standards Department and other ministries and agencies in concern was hold about 170 times.

MCA Minister's public notification will be done on 5th October of this year and it will be applied from next April.

#### 4.3 Main Changes of the content of JSIC

There are no change in the classification system of Division in JSIC.

Main changes are in Major Groups and other lower level. Change of the classification structure (change of the number of classification items) in each level by Division is shown in the next table.

b). F-manufacturing, H-transport and communication, L-services are most revised divisions by reflecting social and economic changes.

In F-manufacturing, main changes are reorganization of F-14 (manufacture of textile mill products) and F-15 (manufacture of apparel and other finished products made from fabrics and similar materials) reflecting the change of business, establishments of F-2742 (optical fiber cables, including telecommunication composite cables), F-3063 (medical instruments electronic equipment), F-3496 (information record materials, except printed products of newspapers and books, etc), and so on reflecting technological innovation and abolishments of old F-1942 (typesetting and lead engraving), old F-3423 (phonograph records), and so on.

In H-transport and communication, most important revision is the establishment of new H-47 (telecommunications) by dividing old H-47 (Communication including postal service and telecommunication) based on the growth of private telecommunication services reflecting deregulation of national telecommunication company's monopoly and technological innovations in this field. And concerning transportation, reorganization of classification has been done reflecting the privatization of Japan National Railways and deregulation of road freight transportation laws.

In L-services, reordering of major groups from L-72 to L-86 has done. Until minth revision, some major groups have been added without clear numbering or ordering rules adhocly in this Division. So, the new numbering rules has been considered in tenth revision. New numbering rule is to arrange various services included in this Division in order of services to parson or family, services to business, and services to public or society. And in this division, many new services such as L-7692 (Marina), L-7693 (recreational fishingguide business), L-7992 (audio and visual record rental, except otherwise classified), L-8695 (worker dispatching service), L-8713 (individual sewage disposal tank cleaning services), L-8724 (industrial waste under special control disposal services) and so on.

Main reason of the change in J-financing and insurance is the review of classification system from a view-point to divide monetary intermediation and other financial intermediation in accordance with TSIC.

#### 5 Comments

#### 5.1 Statistical Needs and Administrative Needs

According to the progress of our society's complexity and manifold, JSIC tends to become in detail. Especially, classification of Industry level has become more detail and detail, because, as explaining in para. 2.3, JSIC is not only used as a statistical standard of many important statistics but also used for deciding applied types of industries or businesses in administration for tax, subsidy, public financing, etc., and in private sector for financing, data information businesses and so on.

Therefore, revision work of JSIC needs so much efforts in order to coordinate needs of ministries and agencies in concern for a long time.

As a matter of fact, Manufacturing Census and Census of Commerce by MITI use Industry level classification for indicating statistical survey's results. And also many statistics compiled based on administrative data of ministries and agencies often use Industry level classification and more detail original classifications. But, other many statistics scarcely use Industry level classification.

# 5.2 Progress of Service Industry and Classification of Services

Generally speaking, as service is often invisible and is difficult to measure by objective methods, often occur troubles between supplier and demander.

Traditional services which get social confidence such as barbarshops, beauty parlors, hotels, restaurant, monetary services and insurance, etc., services which are served with goods such as cleaning, rental services, wholesale, retail, photographic studies, repairing service, etc., services which developed objective measurement unit such as electricity supply, gas supply, etc., and services which are served by professional qualified supplier such as lawyer, patent attorney, etc., are accepted in public.

Therefore, we can easily understand that it is necessary for the development of service industry to keep standardized qualification of service by manualized system, mechnical serving, using objective measurement unit or goods. If these methods is difficult, sometimes content of service contract or trouble resolution system are regulated by law or social rule.

As a matter of facts, most of new classification of L-services in JSIC rev.10 are services which are newly regulated contents of contract, trouble resolution methods, serving qualifications, or other important serving factors by law. This phenomenon shows useful ideas for classification of service industry and classification of service. But, we must recognize that these ideas are not perfectly useful for classifying all services.

Because, new services using telecommunication or electric computer, or new services supplying information in which fields qualification of information, supplying speed, etc., are most important are increasing.

## 5.3 Examination of Establishing Information Industry

One of the most important and difficult proposals is to establish Information Industry as a Division or a Major group by reorganizing F-19 (publishing, printing and allied industries), H-47 (telecommunications), L-80 (motion picture and video production), L-81 (broadcasting), L-82 (information services and research), and other related industries.

More than half of members of Expert Sub-council for Statistical Classifications and Study Group for Statistical Industrial Classification recognize the necessity and importance for analyzing trends of these industries in developed countries.

But, we could not get matured and unified definition of "information" or "information industry", because images of members to these words are manifold.

In the recommendation of the Statistics Council, this problem is rested as a future one.

# 5.4 Another Problem rested to Statistical Standards Department

Another problem rested to Statistical Standards Department is making examination of classification structure of JSIC for the future revision as number of Major groups is filled up to 99. Therefore, we must study how to resolve this problem, by changing its structure from 4 digit figures structure to 5 digit figures one, or by making a rule of "scrap and build" or by other ways.


Nowadays. I am thinking that it is adequate to establish a rule of "scrap and build", but it would be so difficult to find clear and unified classification rule for leveling and numbering.



#### EXPLANATORY NOTES OF DIVISIONS

- A. Agriculture: In this division classified are such establishment as are engaged in farming, livestook breeding (including poultry raising and beeculture) and silkworm raisin as well as those engaged providing services directly related thereto.
- B. Forestry: Classified under this heading are those establishments engaged in fostering forest seedlings, afforestation, fostering and protection of trees, logging, production of firewood and charcoal, collection of resin, tree banks and other forest products, and those services as directly related to forestry, as well as those engaged in game hunting. Establishments engaged in collecting insects, snakes and the like are also classified in this division.
- C. Fisheries: Establishments classified in this category are those engaged in catching or collecting marine animals and plants propagating naturally in the sea or inland water, and those engaged in propagating marine animals and plants by artificial equipment in the sea or inland water. Establishments in fisheries are classified according to the location of fishing grounds and the kinds of fishing boats, fishing methods and fishery products. Establishments in aquaculture are classified according to places of culture, methods of culture and products of culture.
- D. Mining: Establishments classified in this category are those engaged in mining or quarrying the mineral, organic or inorganic, produced naturally in a solid, liquid or gaseous state, and those engaged in screening and other upgrading works. Geological, physical or geochemical surveys or drilling for exploiting mineral resources, mine opening, digging, earth-moving and other works, directly connected with mining are also included.
- E. Construction: Establishments covered under this heading are those engaged

  mainly in contract construction or in construction by themselves

  with their own resources. However, excluded are those

  establishments engaged in maintaining and repairing the structures
  by themselves with their own resources and those engaged in

  planning, inquiries, surveying, designing or supervising

  construction works.

F. Manufacturing: Classified in this heading are those establishments as are engaged in physical or chemical transformation of organic or inorganic substance into new products and in the wholesale thereof.

- . Manufacturing establishments are defined as establishments carrying out mainly the following business.
- (1) Establishments engaged in manufacture and processing of new products.

Establishments engaged in the work of merely selecting or packing products are not classified in manufacturing. Establishments engaged in the work of merely assembling finished parts (assembly work) are classified in manufacturing. However, the assembly work of structures fixing to land is not regarded as manufacturing. It should be noted that some kinds of repair could be regarded as manufacturing. Establishments engaged in such work are classified in manufacturing. Examples are those establishments engaged in ship-repairing. railway rolling-stock repairing or remodeling (excluding railway company's own-account repairs), aircraft overhauling, aircraft engine overhauling and manufacturing-repairing of various types of machinery and its parts by using metal machine tool or metal processing machine.

- (2) Establishments engaged mainly in wholesaling new products. The team " wholesaling " is defined as follow:
  - (a) To sell products to wholesalers and retailers.
  - (b) To sell products in large quantities or in large value to industrial users (factories, mines, construction contractors, corporated agriculturists, forest and fishermen, commercial firms, government offices, public corporations schools, hotels, etc.).
  - (c) To sell commodities of mainly business use (equipment and furniture for office use, equipment and facilities for hospitals, beauty salons, restaurants, etc.).
  - (d) To transfer or deliver products to other establishments belonging to the same enterprise (other factories, sales departments and the like within the same enterprise). The establishments satisfying the above-mentioned conditions (1) and (2) are classified in manufacturing. Therefore, manufactureretailers are not classified under manufacturing.
- G. Electricity, Gas. Heat Supply and Water: Grouped under this heading are those establishments which supply electricity, gas and water (excluding

water for irrigation). Also included are establishments engaged in sewage cleaning, rain draining.

- H. Transport and Communication: In this category included are establishments engaged in transportation of passengers and goods by railways, motor vehicles, vessels, and other transportation means, and in services incidental to transportation, warehousing, communication and services incidental to communication.
- I. Wholesale and Retail trade, Eating and Drinking places: Classified in this division are those establishments specializing as a rule in the resale of tangible commodities. Simple processing such as easy packing, cleaning, selecting, etc., installation and repairing incidental to selling business are included in this category.
- J. Financing and Insurance: Establishments covered under this category are those engaged in financing business (banks, trust companies, other financing institutions, investment companies, security brokers, and commodity brokers and dealers, or insurance business (insurance companies and insurance agents), or in providing services incidental thereto.

  Establishment engaged in government business such as Postal Savings, Post-office Life Insurance, cooperative association's establishments engaged mainly in financing or insurance, establishments of mutual aid organizations for agricultural disaster, fishing boat disaster are included in this division.
- K. Real Estate: Classified under this heading are those establishments specializing mainly in selling, buying, exchanging, renting, or managing real estate, or brokers or agents engaged in selling, buying, renting, or exchanging real estate. Also included are establishments handling the sale and purchase of the ownership of telephones.
- L. Services: Included are establishments which furnish services to individual persons and establishments and which are not classified in other divisions.

This category covers establishments for following services:

(1) miscellaneous services for individual persons and homelife (laundries, barbershops, beauty parlors, bath services, automobile parking, etc.)

- (2) services for amusement and recreation (hotels and other lodging places, emusement services, etc.)
- (3) repair services (automobile repair, machine, upholstery, furniture, etc., repair, etc.)
- (4) goods rental and leasing,
- (5) services for producing and supplying information and knowledge, and services for providing technology or technics for these services (notion picture and video production, radio and television broadcasting, information services and research, advertising, miscellaneous professional services)
- (6) miscellaneous other services for businesses (cooperative associations and other business services)
- (7) waste treatment services
- (8) medical and other health care services; public health services
- (9) social insurance; social welfare
- (0) educational services; research institutes of sciences
- (i) religious services, polítical, business and cultural organizations
- (12) other services (foreign governments and international agencies)
- M. Government( not elsewhere classified establishment): Classified in this category are the central government, its local offices, prefectural governments, municipalities, and townships which are engaged in legislative, judicial and administrative functions.

  Government offices, central or local, which handle non-authoritative businesses by themselves for the society are classified in the industries which handle the said businesses.
- N. Not adequately described: Establishments which cannot be classified in any other divisions are classified in this category. These establishments cannot be classified mainly because of incomplete entry in the questionnaires or schedules of statistical surveys or because of ambiguous entry.

### EXPLANATORY NOTES OF DIVISIONS

- A. Agriculture: In this division classified are such establishment as are engaged in farming, livestock breeding (including poultry raising and beeculture) and silkworm raisin as well as those engaged providing services directly related thereto.
- B. Forestry: Classified under this heading are those establishments engaged in fostering forest seedlings, afforestation, fostering and protection of trees, logging, production of firewood and charcoal, collection of resin, tree barks and other forest products, and those services as directly related to forestry, as well as those engaged in game hunting. Establishments engaged in collecting insects, snakes and the like are also classified in this division.
- C. Fisheries: Establishments classified in this category are those engaged in catching or collecting marine animals and plants propagating naturally in the sea or inland water, and those engaged in propagating marine animals and plants by artificial equipment in the sea or inland water. Establishments in fisheries are classified according to the location of fishing grounds and the kinds of fishing boats, fishing methods and fishery products. Establishments in aquaculture are classified according to places of culture, methods of culture and products of culture.
- D. Mining: Establishments classified in this category are those engaged in mining or quarrying the mineral, organic or inorganic, produced naturally in a solid, liquid or gaseous state, and those engaged in screening and other upgrading works. Geological, physical or geochemical surveys or drilling for exploiting mineral resources, mine opening, digging, earth-moving and other works, directly connected with mining are also included.
- E. Construction: Establishments covered under this heading are those engaged mainly in contract construction or in construction by themselves with their own resources. However, excluded are those establishments engaged in maintaining and repairing the structures by themselves with their own resources and those engaged in planning, inquiries, surveying, designing or supervising construction works.

- F. Manufacturing: Classified in this heading are those establishments as are engaged in physical or chemical transformation of organic or inorganic substance into new products and in the wholesale thereof.

  . Manufacturing establishments are defined as establishments
  - . Manufacturing establishments are defined as establishments carrying out mainly the following business.
  - (1) Establishments engaged in manufacture and processing of new products.

Establishments engaged in the work of merely selecting or packing products are not classified in manufacturing. Establishments engaged in the work of merely assembling finished parts (assembly work) are classified in manufacturing. However, the assembly work of structures fixing to land is not regarded as manufacturing. It should be noted that some kinds of repair could be regarded as manufacturing. Establishments engaged in such work are classified in manufacturing. Examples are those establishments engaged in ship-repairing, railway rolling-stock repairing or remodeling (excluding railway company's own-account repairs), aircraft overhauling, aircraft engine overhauling and manufacturing-repairing of various types of machinery and its parts by using metal machine tool or metal processing machine.

- (2) Establishments engaged mainly in wholesaling new products.
  The team " wholesaling " is defined as follow:
  - (a) To sell products to wholesalers and retailers.
  - (b) To sell products in large quantities or in large value to industrial users (factories, mines, construction contractors, corporated agriculturists, forest and fishermen, commercial firms, government offices, public corporations schools, hotels, etc.).
  - (c) To sell commodities of mainly business use (equipment and furniture for office use, equipment and facilities for hospitals, beauty salons, restaurants, etc.).
  - (d) To transfer or deliver products to other establishments belonging to the same enterprise (other factories, sales departments and the like within the same enterprise).
     The establishments satisfying the above-mentioned conditions (1) and (2) are classified in manufacturing. Therefore, manufacture-retailers are not classified under manufacturing.
- 5. Electricity, Gas, Heat Supply and Water: Grouped under this heading are those establishments which supply electricity, gas and water (excluding

water for irrigation). Also included are establishments engaged in sewage cleaning, rain draining.

- H. Transport and Communication: In this category included are establishments engaged in transportation of passengers and goods by railways, motor vehicles, vessels, and other transportation means, and in services incidental to transportation, warehousing, communication and services incidental to communication.
- I. Wholesale and Retail trade, Eating and Drinking places: Classified in this division are those establishments specializing as a rule in the resale of tangible commodities. Simple processing such as easy packing, cleaning, selecting, etc., installation and repairing incidental to selling business are included in this category.
- J. Financing and Insurance: Establishments covered under this category are those engaged in financing business (banks, trust companies, other financing institutions, investment companies, security brokers, and commodity brokers and dealers, or insurance business (insurance companies and insurance agents), or in providing services incidental thereto.

Establishment engaged in government business such as Postal Savings, Post-office Life Insurance, cooperative association's establishments engaged mainly in financing or insurance, establishments of mutual aid organizations for agricultural disaster, fishing boat disaster are included in this division.

- K. Real Estate: Classified under this heading are those establishments specializing mainly in selling, buying, exchanging, renting, or managing real estate, or brokers or agents engaged in selling, buying, renting, or exchanging real estate. Also included are establishments handling the sale and purchase of the ownership of telephones.
- L. Services: Included are establishments which furnish services to individual persons and establishments and which are not classified in other divisions.

This category covers establishments for following services:

 miscellaneous services for individual persons and homelife (laundries, barbershops, beauty parlors, bath services, automobile parking, etc.)

- (2) services for amusement and recreation (hotels and other lodging places, amusement services, etc.)
- (3) repair services (automobile repair, machine, upholstery, furniture, etc., repair, etc.)
- (4) goods rental and leasing,
- (5) services for producing and supplying information and knowledge, and services for providing technology or technics for these services (motion picture and video production, radio and television broadcasting, information services and research, advertising, miscellaneous professional services)
- (6) miscellaneous other services for businesses (cooperative associations and other business services)
- (7) waste treatment services
- (8) medical and other health care services; public health services
- (9) social insurance; social welfare
- (10) educational services; research institutes of sciences
- (1) religious services, political, business and cultural organizations
- (12) other services (foreign governments and international agencies)
- M. Government( not elsewhere classified establishment): Classified in this category are the central government, its local offices, prefectural governments, municipalities, and townships which are engaged in legislative, judicial and administrative functions. Government offices, central or local, which handle non-authoritative businesses by themselves for the society are classified in the industries which handle the said businesses.
- N. Not adequately described: Establishments which cannot be classified in any other divisions are classified in this category. These establishments cannot be classified mainly because of incomplete entry in the questionnaires or schedules of statistical surveys or because of ambiguous entry.
