Trade services in a revised CPC Some further considerations

I. Introduction

- 1. Current CPC distinguishes about 100 subclasses for wholesale and retail trade services (excluding motor vehicle sales and commission agents' services). These subclasses are defined by range of goods traded. Reference to ISIC Rev. 3 is only given for specialized trade, but not for non-specialized trade. CPA bases its elements on that of the CPC but has subdivided many CPC subclasses. Furthermore, CPA also introduced items for non-specialized and other forms of trade without further subdividing these items.
- 2. Both CPC and CPA label their trade items by using the term "services" (wholesale trade services; retail sales or retailing services) without specifying how these services should be measured. From the national accounts point of view trade services are measured by the respective margins. However, in economic statistics one would primarily survey trade turnover, differentiated by wholesale and retail and by goods traded. Such data are also important for national accounts as they provide the basis for calculating the trade margins.
- 3. At its Ottawa meeting (April 1995) the CPC subgroup discussed the principal problems involved with a product classification for trade services and came to the conclusion that obviously two types of classifications should be distinguished:
 - classification of trade services
 - classification of goods traded.
- 4. Based on that principle the author was asked to elaborate a detailed proposal to be considered for the further work of the CPC subgroup. However, in the following just further considerations are presented. As the new approach would mean a total reorientation compared to current CPC, it seems desirable to have a broad discussion. This is the main reason why this interim report is addressed to the Voorburg Group.

II. Current CPC and CPA

5. As already stated, current CPC distinguishes about 100 categories for trade. All subclasses have references to ISIC Rev. 3. However, there are no subclasses which are referenced to ISIC Rev. 3 5190 Other wholesale and to all classes of non-specialized retail trade (group 521). The introduction just states:service categories.

- ries refer to the specialized stores only, because such reference is more specific" (§ 27). No reason is given for not referencing to ISIC Rev. 3 5190, a class which according to explanatory notes includes specialized wholesale not covered in one of the previous categories.
- 6. It thus seems that the intention of CPC was to provide a classification of trade items which could be used for measuring trading by goods traded. All CPC subclasses are defined by listing the respective transportable goods. If that was the intention of CPC, it would have been more consistent not to refer to ISIC Rev. 3 at all. However, the CPC subclasses use the term "services" by which one would be inclined to view these items as categories for measuring trade services (margins?).
- 7. As elsewhere, CPA used also the CPC items as building blocks for the trade categories. Contrary to CPC, each item is structurally linked to one of the trade activities of NACE Rev.1. As there were not CPC items for non-specialized trade, CPA introduced new ones. As a classification linked to activities, CPA intends to provide a classification to measure the products (i.e. trade services). However, the CPA categories should also be used for collecting data on goods traded and hence it was criticized that the items for non-specialized trade are insufficient for that purpose. Proposals are discussed to subdivide them. Clearly, the CPA approach is unsatisfactory as detailed subcategories are provided for specialized trade only. However, CPA had in mind that the trade margins are to be viewed as products of trade, thus, too much detail is inappropriate. Obviously, it follows that the subcategories for specialized trade are too disaggregated, as such items would only be useful if separate trading activities are existent.
- 8. Hence, neither the CPC nor the CPA approach is satisfactory: the CPC provides a classification for measuring trade revenues by goods rather than a classification of trade services, whereas the CPA uses a classification of goods traded as a classification of trade services. It has thus to be concluded that a revised CPC should include a classification of trade services and (as an annex) a classification of goods

traded.² For the latter one the current CPC items could serve as a basis. However, for the first type there is yet no (international) example.

III. Classification of trade services

- 9. In elaborating a classification of trade services one has to ask about the criteria to distinguish different kinds of trading services. Obviously, one criteria would be whether the distribution service is oriented to retailers, to commercial, to industrial and to other institutional or professional business users on the one hand, or to private households on the other hand. Thus, it seems useful and applicable to distinguish between wholesale trade and retail trade services.
- 10. Within wholesale trade services the same question has to be raised: are there different types of wholesale trade services and if, how are they to be distinguished. Usually, one would take into consideration the (economic) nature of the services. By definition trade services are services providing transportable goods that were bought on the risk of the trader intended for resale without changing the physical nature of the good. The goods for resale may be bought at the domestic market or abroad, they may be intended for sale at the domestic market or abroad; they may also be bought abroad and sold abroad (transit trade).
- 11. Empirical evidence shows that the price of the wholesale trade services (margins) usually differ by goods traded. Hence, a classification of wholesale trade services could be elaborated along the current CPC lines. However, such a classification may not be as detailed as the current CPC, but should at least be as detailed as the class level of ISIC Rev. 3.
- 12. Clearly, there are other determinants of the wholesale price (import and export trade, trade specialization, size of the unit, integrated services, etc.). However it seems difficult to base a classification of general validity on such determinants.
- 13. Concerning retail trade services the most important determinant of the price reters to the distinction of specialized and non-specialized trade and within those catego-

ries to the kinds of goods traded. Again, these distinctions are already incorporated in ISIC Rev. 3. At the highest level this would result into three categories:

- Non-specialized retail trade services in stores
- Specialized retail trade services in stores
- Retail trade services not in stores.

However, the third category could be deleted as also retail trade services not in stores can be split in specialized and non-specialized ones.

14. The more or less strict alignment of the trade service categories to the structure of ISIC Rev. 3 may not be seen attractive from the merely product point of view. (CPC being different from the structure of ISIC.) However, it seems that the most important criteria can only be applied if variables of the units providing these services are taken into account, or more specifically, if the nature of the provision of trade services is considered rather than the kinds of goods involved only.³

IV. Classification of goods traded

- 15. The other classification concerning trade in a revised CPC would be a classification of goods traded. This classification would be a kind of an annex classification rather than part of the core of the system. As stated above, the current CPC items would be viewed as (or are intentionally) a classification of goods traded. However, the structure should be reviewed too.⁴
- 16. In elaborating a classification of products traded at least the following aspects have to be considered:
 - such a classification should not be too detailed as it is intended for worldwide application;
 - the structure should be applicable for all trade branches, irrespective of specialized or non-specialized trade;

It should be noted that there are many other items in CPC which are defined by using criteria of the unit providing that services: e.g. 64210 Meal serving services with full restaurant service and 64220 Meal serving services in self-service facilities.

- there should only be one classification of goods traded which could be applied both for the wholesale and for the retail trade branches (even if not all goods are traded in retail trade);
- the structure should not necessarily be identical with the structure of the trade branches because not much insight into the product composition of the single trade branches would be gained (except concerning "non-characteristic" products traded);
- the classification should really be a "classification", not only a list of goods; this
 would enable the user to apply different levels of the hierarchy in different trade
 branches and at the same time allow useful aggregation;
- each transportable good should be attributed to one product group only (this is not the case in current CPC and may not be applicable in all cases);
- in a classification of goods traded the classification elements should be labeled by their name as transportable goods (rather than as wholesale trade services of ... - or retail sales of ...).
- 17. One of the main problems of applying the current CPC items is that the contem of each item is not always clearly defined and there are numerous cases of differences between the titles and the explanatory notes. In order to elaborate improved explanatory notes for the CPA trade items Eurostat organized a couple of meetings. The aim of these meetings was to attribute each transportable product category to one wholesale and one retail sale item of CPA. The result of that work ("Trade defined by products traded") transformed to CPC items can be found in table 1. In the left column of table 1 the CPC definition and in the right column the CPA definition of the CPC trade items are shown. As can be seen, the CPA definitions are much more specific than those of the CPC, but also the coverage of many items are seen differently. It also turned out that many CPC subclasses of transportable goods are not homogenous to attribute them to only one trade item. Those items are indicated in table 1 by an asterix. Obviously, if the current CPC trade items should serve as a basis for the classification of products traded the different interpretations have to be taken into account.
- 18. Testing the current CPC items with respect to structural symmetry between who e-sale and retail trade shows that most of the items have the same coverage between

wholesale and retail trade (at least intentionally) (table 2). Problem areas are food products, non-electrical household equipment, stationery and office supplies (apart from 63244, 63296 and 63299). Some of the asymmetrical cases have already implicitly been solved by CPA as CPA is more detailed than CPC.

19. It thus seems that current CPC items would have to be restructured to a very considerable extent in order to yield the desired classification of goods traded. Nevertheless, it seems advisable to start with current CPC in the interpretation of its contents given by CPA. This would make sure that all transportable product categories would be considered.⁵

V. Concluding remarks

- 20. The present paper is a report of work in progress (not only by the author). Discussions within the CPC subgroup and other contributions lead to the preliminary result that for trade in CPC two distinct classifications seems conceptually appropriate. In elaborating those two types of classifications the present state of work is as follows: a classification of trade services will be more directly linked to the activities (as defined in ISIC Rev. 3); a classification of goods traded should start with current CPC, however, a considerable restructuring seems necessary.
- 21. Considering that the new approach would mean a total reorientation, the Voorburg Group is asked to discuss the general principle as well as to give advice concerning classification structures and details. The Voorburg Group is also asked to provide information regarding country experience in collecting trade revenue data by products traded.⁶

If a similar approach will be applied for goods transportation too (classification of transport services and classification of goods transported), it seems advisable to design those classifications such that the classification of goods transported.

The author was provided by a detailed list which the Bureau of the Census uses to collect product tata on its Census of Retail Trade.
