  - animal ambulance activities

Services are carried out by qualified veterinarians

In veterinary hospitals, visiting farms, kennels or homes

# Product classification

Veterinary activities has the same three products in both CPC and CPA The items includes:

Animal and veterinary hospital and non-hospital medical, surgical and dental services

aimed for curing, restoring and / or maintaining the health of the animal

laboratory, technical services, food and other facilities and resources

Other veterinary services including zoo animals and animals raised for products (fur and other)
