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

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

# PPI: Main Characteristics

- ▶ 2013 NAICS Sectorial Coverage: 75%
- ▶ Base Period: July 2019 = 100
- ▶ Basket: 560 goods and service products
- ▶ National Production Coverage: 79%
- ▶ National Geographic Coverage
- ▶ Laspeyres Index

Posibility to measure sampling quality and perform statistical inference




Numerous establishments with low participation rate

# Cut – off Sampling for SPPIs


Major service providers that lead the industry are selected



Economic units are ordered based on their percentage share of sales turnover

## Probabilistic

- ▶ Stratified sampling



- ▶ Simple Random Sampling in each stratum




## Non - Probabilistic

- ▶ Fees are regulated by the government
- ▶ Few services providers
- ▶ Services related to housing




# Statistical Business Register of Mexico: RENEM

- Demographic variables
- Identification key



# Non - Probabilistic Sampling Quality

## INEGI's Quality Assurance Committee: Coverage indicators

Coverage range	Indicator
Greater than or equal to 80%	High
Greater than or equal to 60% and less than 80%	Medium
Less than 60%	Low



## Sample Rotation of Establishments

- Selected economic unit remains in the sample until the following base period change or until a change of PPI weights occurs. This causes wear on the informant and lose of representativeness of the sample due to establishments closures and births
- Launch an annual or biannual rotation of the sample based on RENEM updates to allow the sampling frames to be kept up to date; while the frames are updated, the samples will remain fixed

# Sampling in the New Normal

- Economic units most affected are those related to the provision of services
- Consumption patterns are changing
- Temporary or definitive closure of the service providers
- Decrease in the variety of services
- Under-coverage of the sampling frames derived from the definitive closure of operations of economic units
