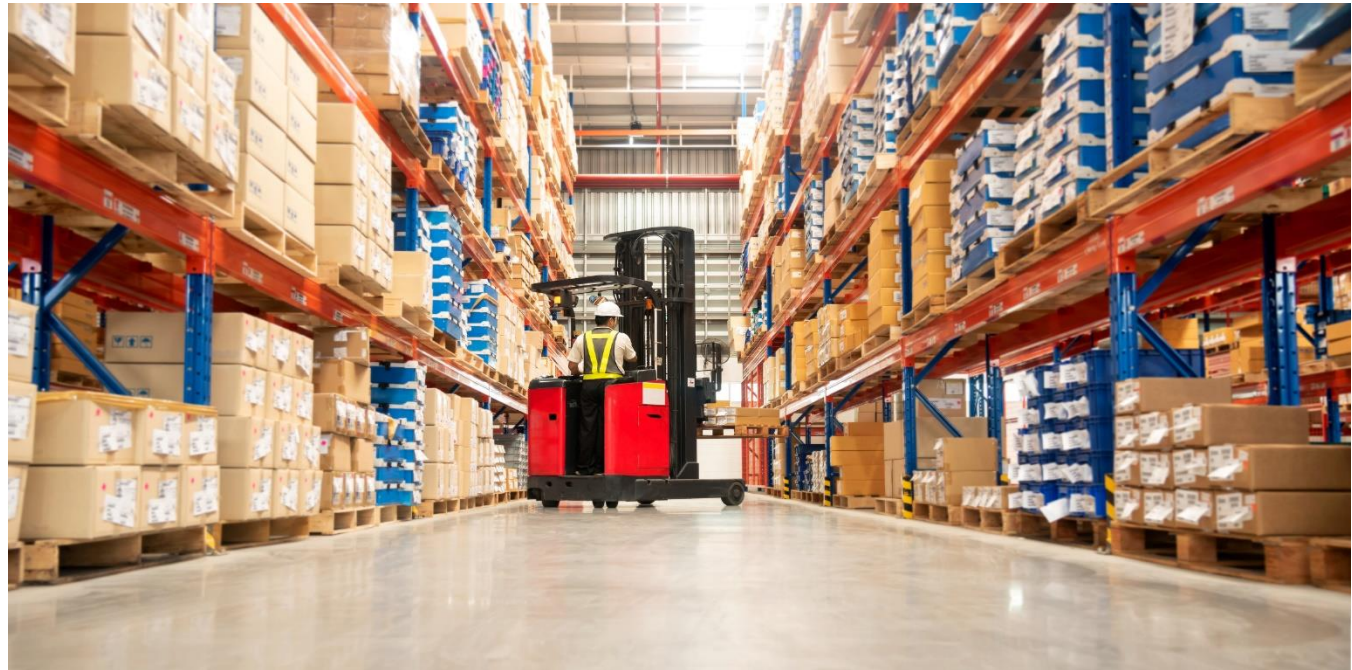

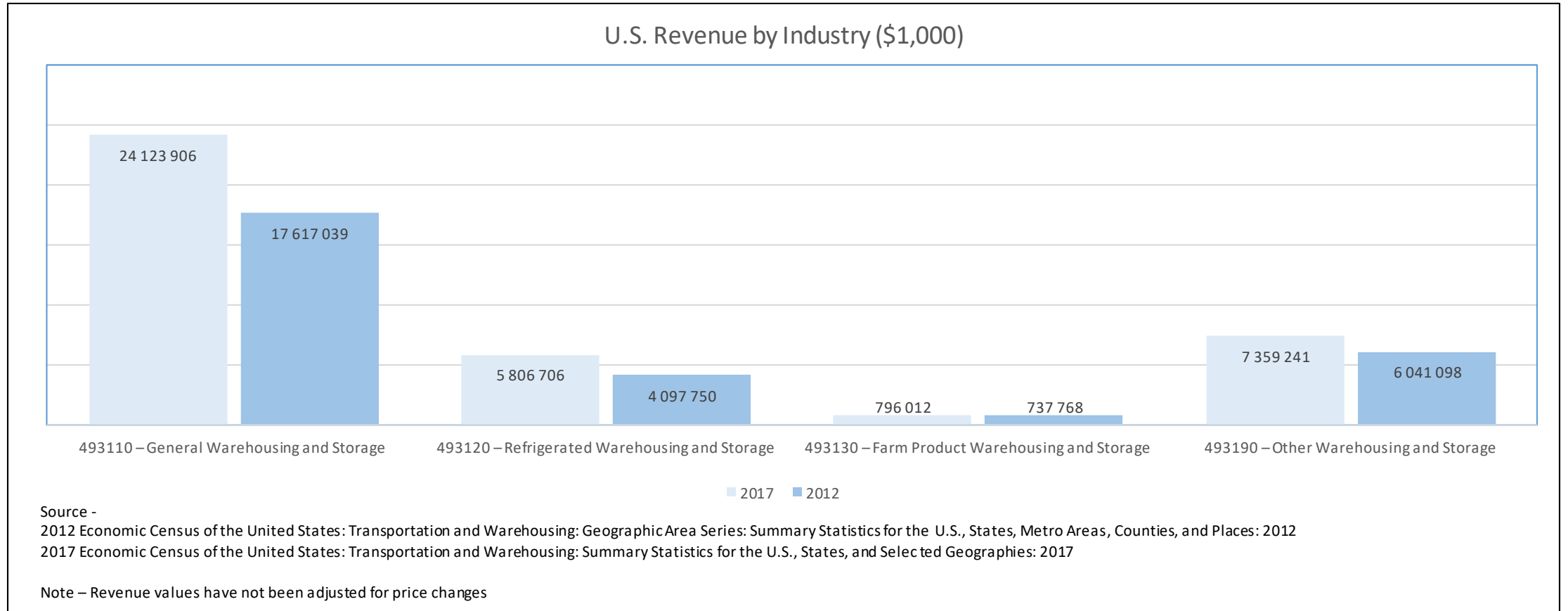

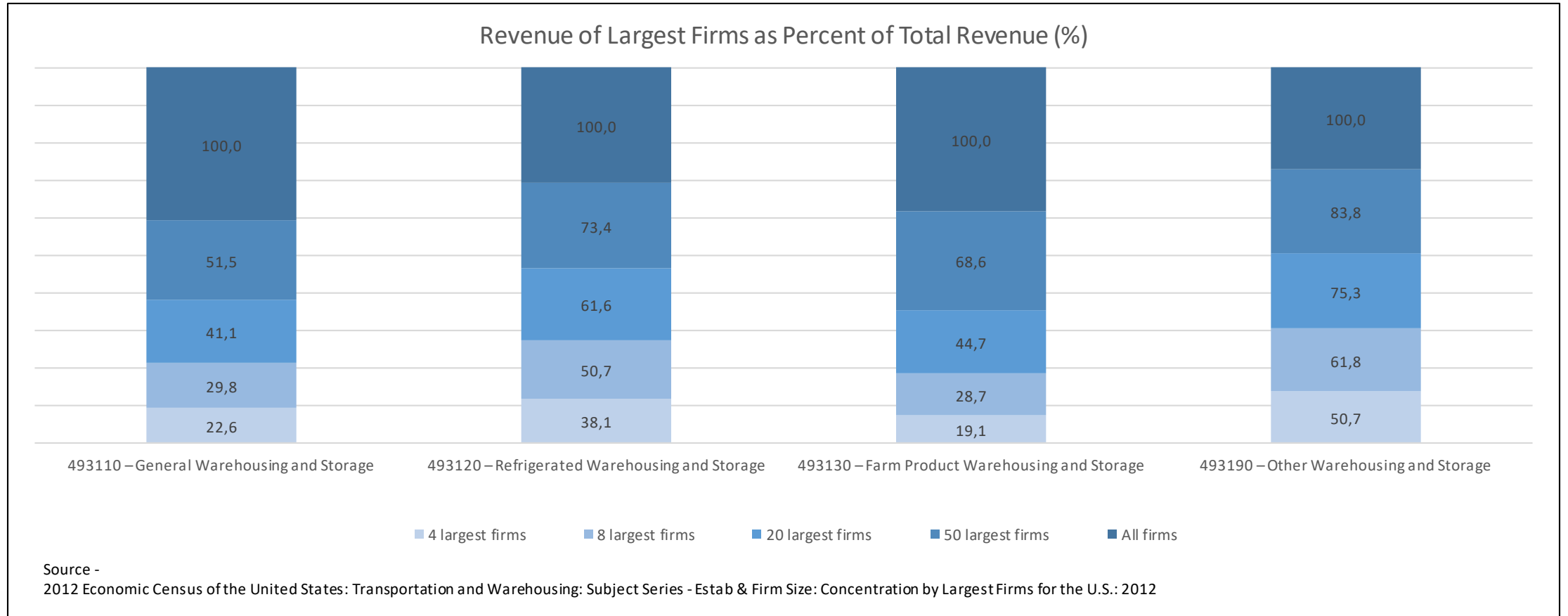
Industry Definition

- ISIC class 5210 is associated with four NAICS (North American Industry Classification System) industries as collected and published by the Census Bureau
 - 493110 – General Warehousing and Storage
 - 493120 – Refrigerated Warehousing and Storage
 - 493130 – Farm Product Warehousing and Storage
 - 493190 – Other Warehousing and Storage
- Locations are classified based on the type of product they are providing warehousing and storage services for.

Market Conditions in the U.S.



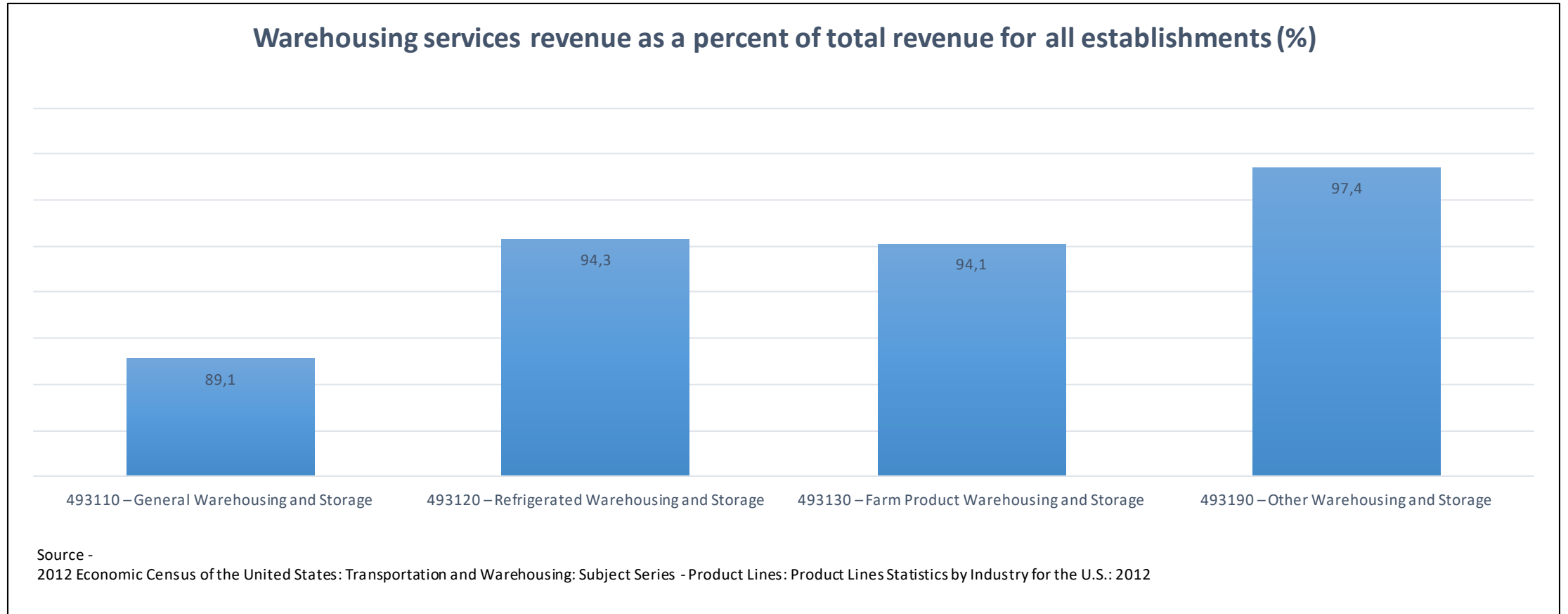

Definition of Output

- Output for the warehousing industries tend to fall under three categories:
 - Storage services
 - Handling services for goods
 - Packing services for goods

Measurement Issues

- The NAPCS mentioned are all considered primary to each of the warehousing industries. As such, NAPCS alone can not be used for the determination of NAICS industry classification.
 - Use of a self-designated kind-of-business check-box is used to assist in classification for these industries
