Services provided

- ISIC 7730 includes renting and operational leasing, without operator, of:
 - Machinery and equipment that are generally used as capital goods by industries
 - ► Land-transport equipment (other than motor vehicles)
 - ► Water-transport equipment
 - ► Air-transport equipment
 - ► Agricultural and forestry machinery and equipment
 - ► Construction and civil-engineering machinery and equipment
 - ► Office machinery and equipment



Services excluded

- ISIC 7730 excludes:
 - ► Renting of machinery or equipment with operator (see 0161, 0240, divisions 43, 50, 51)
 - ► Financial leasing (see 6491)
 - ▶ Renting of pleasure boats (see 7721)
 - ► Renting of bicycles (see 7721)





Market Conditions

- Industry Size
 - ► Small portion of overall economic activity
 - ► Significant portion of the rental and leasing sector
- Industry Concentration
 - ► Moderate concentration in Canada and France
 - ▶ Dominated by small enterprises in Sweden and Estonia
- Type of Buyer is primarily businesses



Specific Characteristics

- Rental and leasing may be preferred to purchasing equipment
 - ▶ Particularly during economic downturns and times of uncertainty
 - ► Access to up-to date equipment
 - ► Reduced up-front capital expenditures
 - Can adjust production capacities more quickly
- Increasing digitization of industry operations in Canada
 - ► Real time online inventories
 - ► Development of mobile apps to manage inventories and interface with customers

Revenue/Output Measurement: General Framework

- Turnover collection supported by legislation on EU level
 - ► STS Short-Term Statistics (Quarterly)
 - ► SBS Structural Business Statistics (Annually)
- Turnover measures in Canada
 - ► Annual Survey of Service Industries
 - Industry output is estimated based on operating revenues plus own-account capital formation.

Output/Turnover: Methods & Issues

- Combination of administrative and survey data
 - ► Tax data used as a sample frame and for key financial variables
 - ► Survey data provide more detailed information
- Reporting of data at the enterprise vs establishment level
 - Preliminary provincial data over or underestimated
 - ▶ Primary activity of the larger entity may differ from the establishment
- Maintaining an accurate business register



SPPI: General Framework

- In Europe, SPPI is compiled in the system of short-term statistics
 - Published quarterly
 - ► Publication level varies by country

- Primary Uses:
 - ▶ Deflator for Gross Domestic Product in National Accounts
 - ► Deflator for Service Production Indices
 - Leading indicator of inflation



SPPI: Price Determining Characteristics

- Type of equipment rented
- Duration of the rental
- Inclusion of associated services
 - ► Transportation of equipment
 - ► Fuel
 - ► Maintenance

SPPI: Measurement Issues

■ Sampling:

- ▶ Difficult to maintain an accurate business register
- ► Establishments may have significant activity in multiple industries

Data Sources:

- ▶ No sources of administrative or other third-party data reported
- Inconsistent availability of price data online
- ► Online pricing does not include negotiated discounts



SPPI: Additional Measurement Issues

- Quality Adjustment:
 - ► Changes to the machinery or equipment
 - ► Changes in the rental service
- New vs. Existing Leases
 - ► Ideally should be collected and weighted separately
 - ► Online pricing does not include existing leases



Evaluation of Measurement

- Survey response is a challenge
 - ▶ Online price collection can reduce respondent burden
 - Lacks negotiated discounts and existing leases
- **■** Future challenges
 - ► Tracking sales made on digital platforms
 - ▶ Potential for web scraping vs manual online price collection
 - ► Implementation of FRIBS regulations




International Progress

- 13 countries responded to the Alternative Data Source Survey
- Turnover/Output Collection
 - ▶8 countries collect turnover data
 - ► Primary sources of data are questionnaires and Structural Business Statistics
- Prices Collection
 - ▶ 11 countries collect price data
 - ▶ Primary sources of data are questionnaires and websites
