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

Sample Rotation of Establishments

- closures and births
- remain fixed



Selected economic unit remains in the sample until the following base period change or until a change of PPI weights occurs. This causes wear on the informant and lose of representativeness of the sample due to establishments

• Launch an annual or biannual rotation of the sample based on RENEM updates to allow the sampling frames to be kept up to date; while the frames are updated, the samples will

Difficulties and Challenges
