


When and why creating groups?

The Global Network

- where a restricted community
- can gather around a common challenge,
- and starts exchanging knowledge and directly usable information.







When IT IS a good idea to create a group

You need a group when you:

- want to address a specific topic
- want to exchange information or ask/receive feedback about it
- want to create/engage in a discussion about it
- want to engage peers to discuss about it
- want to keep collaborating, having discussions between in-person meetings





Conditions for a group to be active and useful to its members

- Relevant audience
- A clear objective
 - Which topic(s) will be covered?
- Moderators allocate time to respond/curate content
- Co-facilitators & champions are actively involved
- Regular and relevant information
- Engaging discussions
- Provide useful resources
